ASSISTANCE FOR THOSE IN NEED IN ISRAEL

Hamas has launched over 2,000 rockets into Israel since the beginning of "Operation Protective Edge."

These rockets are fired randomly across civilian areas from Beersheva to Jerusalem to Modi'in to Tel Aviv to Haifa and areas in between. Southern Israel, nearest Gaza, has been hardest hit.

The Jewish Federations of North America (JFNA) has launched an effort to raise \$10 million for assistance to those impacted by the current situation in Israel.

The funds will be used to provide:

- 20,000 children who live within 25 miles of Gaza a safe summer experience away from the line of fire
- Thousands of elderly and new immigrants with food and comfort in these stressful times
- Trauma support for those whose homes have been damaged, who have been injured or are in shock from the attacks
- Help for the municipalities in the hardest hit areas to help them manage the challenging situation

Rochester was asked to provide at least \$48,000 as our fair share of these emergency funds. Knowing the urgency, Federation leaders approved sending all of the request immediately, even before we a penny was raised.
