It is that time again. This month we start the new year 5784 with Erev Rosh Hashanah services at BHBI on Friday, September 15 at 7 pm. Services will again be led by Dr. George Kornfeld. Morning services will continue on Saturday and Sunday at 9 am. Please come early so that we will be sure to have a minyan present at the necessary times. Then throw your sins away at Tashlich, which we will have on Rosh Hashanah 2nd day, Sunday September 17, at 4 pm. As we did last year, we will meet in the Temple B'rith Kodesh parking lot by door A, and proceed down the Brickyard Trail to feed the ducks and other waterfowl.

In advance of Rosh Hashanah, we will have a morning Selichot service on Sunday, September 10, at 9:30 am, in person at BHBI. The program, which is not yet finalized, may involve viewing of some appropriate film.

We will continue with Yom Kippur with Kol Nidre service on Sunday, September 24, at 6:40 pm. Yom Kippur morning service, including the Yizkor service, will start Monday at 9:00 am. The fast ends at 7:45 pm. See the calendar on page 2 for further details.

As we start a new year, I wish to take this opportunity to thank all the Congregation's Officers and Board Members, who contribute so much throughout the year to keep our congregation going.
