

March's President's Message

Friends,

March is upon us, and spring will soon be here. Spring is a time for new beginnings, and at BHBI we have two new developments. Firstly, we have now employed a security guard to be present in the building for the duration of our Shabbat morning services. We are all aware of the troubling increase in antisemitic activity that has occurred throughout the country, and while we are not aware of any particular threats towards our shul, or the Rochester area more generally, the Board felt it prudent to act with an abundance of caution, and to employ a guard. Please say hello to Mike, our security guard, when he greets you at the door on Shabbat.

We have also made some modifications to the precautions that were instituted with the onset of the Covid pandemic. While Covid remains a threat, the CDC rating for hospital admissions in our area is currently Low, and so the Board has decided to make the following two changes. Beginning in March, we will resume our normal (pre-Covid) start time of 9:30 AM for Shabbat morning services, restoring the sections of pesukei dezmirot and shachrit that were abridged during Covid. The Torah service will continue to begin at approximately 10:30 AM. We have also decided that those who wish to unmask may now do so provided (1) they have had the current year's Covid and flu vaccinations, (2) they are seated at the luncheon tables on the west side of the sanctuary. To find the current Covid risk level, visit the <u>CDC website</u>, scroll down to Covid-19 County Check, and enter "NY" and "Monroe." The risk is updated every Thursday at 8pm.

Our Erev Purim Service will take place at 7:45 PM on Saturday, March 23, at BHBI. Please come to hear the whole megillah! There will be no service on Purim day, the following Sunday.

SHABBAT SERVICES

BHBI has in-person **Shabbat Morning Services**, each Saturday at 9:30 AM. We meet indoors in our sanctuary, where we have six HEPA air filtering units running. All attendees must be vaccinated against Covid and wear a face mask, except when sitting at the kiddish tables on the west side of the sanctuary. Masks are available in the sanctuary for those who need. Seating is socially distanced. Sunday morning services continue on Zoom at 9:00 AM, see the shul website for the Zoom link.
